What does a Workplace Inspection help to do?

Compliance to safety legislation – determine if workplace practices are meeting legislative requirements.

Hazards - Addresses issues such as (not limited to) confined space entry, working at heights, noise, plant, manual tasks and involve the inspection and testing of current workplace control methods.

This inspection identifies your business' critical risks and helps you to ensure these risks are managed so no one is harmed or injured.

What an inspection will tell you:

- How well you are performing in relation to health and safety;
- Whether your business leaders and workers are meeting the standards which the company has set itself;
- If you have effective processes in place to comply with the health and safety legislation;
- Critical risks that need immediate attention; and
- Opportunities for improvement with recommendations to improve business performance, safety culture and results.
